What you need to bring to camp:

- +Bedroll and **individual** sleeping mattress
- +Personal care items (soap, towel, etc.)
- +Clean clothes (including long-sleeved shirts and jeans for Rodeo)
- +No spaghetti straps, midriff showing, low-cut revealing tops or short shorts.
- +Bible and notebook
- +Western boots, hat & rain gear
- +Saddle horse (if you have) & gear
- +Rodeo equipment (if you have any)
- +Hay, feed & water bucket, as needed
- +Swimsuit for in open showers, if desired

Please Note:

- +Long-sleeved shirts, boots, jeans and hat must be worn while competing in the arena (not necessary during clinics)
- +**Campers will sleep with their assigned group, near their Team Leader**
- +Clearly mark all belongings with your name.
- +No trailers are to be parked in tack area overnight. Parking provided.
- +Only paid, signed up youth are allowed to stay overnight on rodeo grounds, due to insurance issues.
- +No dogs.
- +Leave your CD players and cell phones at home or turn them in at the office.
- +Absolutely no drugs, alcohol or tobacco.
- + **NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR LOST OR STOLEN ARTICLES!**
- + All campers are required to attend all scheduled activities.

Camp will end following the presentation of ALL awards on the last day of Rodeo Bible Camp. Campers will not be released and stall fees will not be given out before the Awards Ceremony is completely over. Due to the increased number of campers, plan to stay a while and honor all of them!

1. **Acknowledgment of Risk:** The undersigned acknowledge(s) that activity related to livestock, rodeo, trail ride, and horsemanship events are dangerous activities and that participation in rodeo training activities and other rodeo related activities expose the participant to a substantial and serious risk of property damage, personal injury, and even death. Notwithstanding the risk involved, the undersigned expressly consent(s) to the participant assuming such risk.

2. **Release of Sponsors and Others:** The undersigned being fully aware that participating in the Northeast Oregon Christian Cowboys Rodeo Bible Camp and the activities related thereto, will expose participant to a substantial and even serious risk of property damage, personal injury or death hereby releases and forever discharges the Northeast Oregon Christian Cowboys, their respective officers, directors, agents, employees, successors and assigns, and anyone acting on their behalf, from any and all damages, costs, losses, claims, actions or causes of action of every kind and nature, whether past, present or future, arising out of or in any way connected with the participant=s participation in or attendance at Rodeo Bible Camp.
